WHO WE ARE...



We take a community approach to ending homelessness by operating in neighbourhoods where people can use a hand up and who require safe, affordable accommodations.

We own and operate a historic hotel in Ogden and have successfully converted it into safe, affordable housing for 59 men.

Now after 18 years of serving the community of Forest Lawn, we have fully purchased the old Town and Country Hotel and will reproduce the Ogden model with 48 units for women, children and seniors.

THE FINANCIAL GOAL

- \$14 million project
- \$9 million committed to date
- \$5 million balance to complete the project
(based on current estimates)

The 3 phases of the Project:

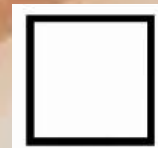
- Phase 1
- Purchase land and building paid in full.
\$4 million



- Phase 2
Asbestos removal, new exterior around living accommodations and windows committed to and in process.
\$5 million



- Phase 3
- Interior includes 48 units, retail and common space.
- Last phase to the finish line!
\$5 million to raise
